Format for abstract: Please provide the following in the abstract:

Title, Author(s), Institution(s), name, phone no. and email of presenting author
Structure the abstract into Background, Methods, Results and Conclusion.

Word limit 300 words + up to 3 photographs and / or tables

Type in single space, Arial 12 size font, A4 size paper,

For Videos: include Diagnosis, Pre-op preparation, Name & Steps of surgical procedure in the abstract

Abstracts will be accepted only once the presenting author must have registered for SGPGI Breast course and paid registration fee

Incomplete abstracts such as those stating "results will be discussed" will not be considered.

All accepted abstracts (except videos) will be presented as posters. Five best posters would be selected for short presentation (3 minutes for presentation, with maximum 5 powerpoint slides + 2 minutes for Q&A) in an award session. Best two papers would be awarded prizes.

Department of Endocrine & Breast Surgery, SGPGIMS

The department of Endocrine & Breast Surgery at SGPGIMS, Lucknow is a pioneer in the field of clinical practice, training and teaching as well as research in the areas of endocrine and breast surgery in India. It was established in September 1989, and was the first academic department of Endocrine & Breast Surgery in India which offered opportunity for dedicated training in this specialty. The department is credited with starting the first post-doctoral certificate course (PDCC) in Endocrine Surgery in India in 1997, and later was the first one to start a three year MCh Endocrine Surgery course in the year 2004. The department attracts large numbers of referrals from various parts of India, and neighboring countries for complex endocrine and breast surgical problems, and is acknowledged as one of few high-quality centers for complex re-operative thyroid surgery, surgery for primary hyperparathyroidism, pheochromocytoma and other adrenal tumors, multiple endocrine neoplasia syndromes; and sentinel lymph node biopsy, breast conservation and oncoplastic surgical procedures as part of comprehensive multi-modal treatment for early and advanced breast cancers. The department has pioneered minimally invasive endocrine surgical procedures, notably laparoscopic adrenal surgery, minimally invasive parathyroidectomy and video-assisted thoracoscopic (VATS) thymectomy; and sentinel lymph node biopsy and conservation/ oncoplastic breast surgery in the country.

Travel Grant

SGPGI Breast Health Program will support participation of young and in-training doctors in the workshop and breast course. Travel grant will include:

- re-imbursement of full registration fee of course and workshop deposited
- re-imbursement of full 2nd AC to-and-fro train fare between place of work and Lucknow station
- a certificate of travel award.

These would be awarded during the valedictory session on second day of the course.

Who is eligible: Post-graduate students- junior or senior residents, registrars, MS, MD DNB, MCh, DM students, who have submitted an abstract for presentation of a poster/ paper at the SGPGI breast course-2014.

How to apply: You can apply only once you have submitted the abstract for presentation at SGPGI Breast course 2014, and have sent your registration form along with registration fee. The course would also provide opportunities for the young surgeons, surgical trainees to show-case their clinical and research work in form of posters and videos. The most notable of videos and posters would be awarded prizes. There would be opportunities for young surgeons, radiation oncologists and trainees to avail one of many travel grants/ awards which would facilitate their participation in this course. The organizing team at SGPGIMS would leave no stones unturned to look after our guests during this course, and are hopeful that all our guests would go back with good memories of the **Lucknawi Mehman-nawazi and Avadhi Zaika**.
